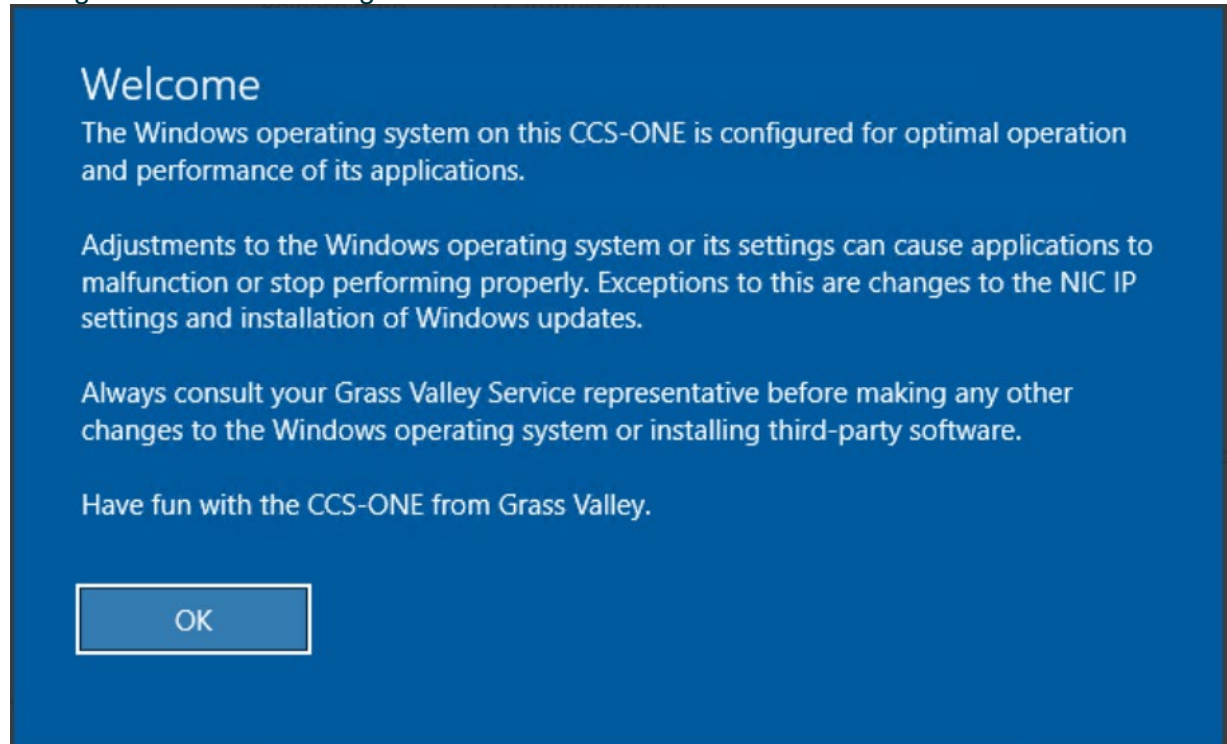

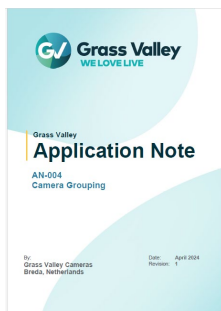
- **Camera grouping.**

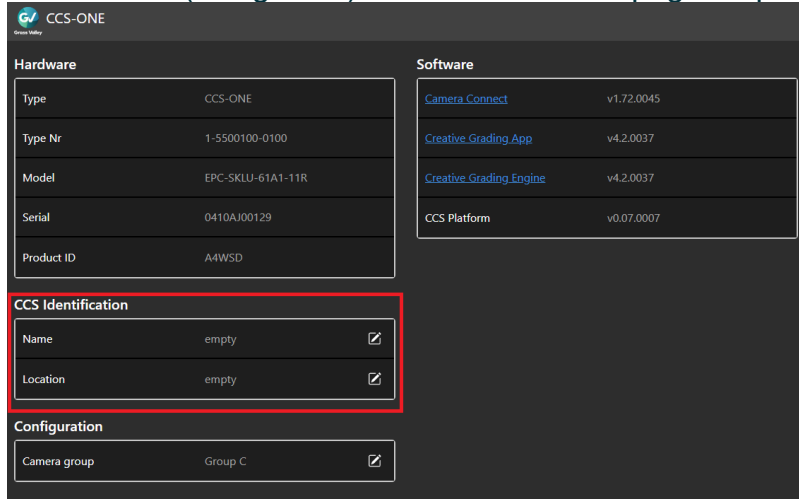
